A quality education is the best way to achieve economic self-sufficiency.


Students rely on a community of support, so they can learn to rely on themselves. The cost for one student is shared across multiple sources:

How it works



COMPANIES contract directly with Cristo Rey for full-time, entry-level jobs. We act as a temp agency, so you don't have to worry about tax forms and other employee-related paperwork.



STUDENTS contribute to the cost of their education by working five full days a month (Mon-Fri), performing a wide range of tasks tailored to the needs of each corporate partner.



CRISTO REY RELATIONSHIP MANAGERS provide highly structured workplace support and integrate a standards-based curriculum.
